2016 T-Ball League Special Ground Rules

1. These are attached to the Chehalis Little League ground rules and incorporate all parts of those rules not in conflict with these special rules, which apply to A League.
2. Games are scheduled for three innings. On school nights, no inning may start after 8 p.m. On non-school nights a 10 p.m. curfew applies. On nights when two games are scheduled on the same field, no inning may start after one hour and 45 minutes of play.
3. No score or standings are kept.
4. All players will play at all times. All players are entered in the batting order, and all players will be on the field defensively. Only the players at pitcher, catcher, first base, second base, third base and shortstop can be in the infield. All other players must remain on the outfield grass and in fair territory.
5. All players bat every offensive half of an inning.
6. The ball must be hit from the Tee. The ball must travel at least 10 feet to be considered in play; otherwise it is considered a foul ball. Players will continue to swing until the ball is put in play. If the ball is not hit after 5 swings, the coach should assist to get the ball in play. Bunting is not allowed.
7. A runner put out on a defensive play will stay on base to gain experience running the bases. All infield hits are limited to singles.
8. Stealing and sliding are not allowed. Runners must remain in contact with the base until the ball is hit.
9. When the last offensive player in the order bats, the coach must let the defensive team know that the last batter is up. On a play by the last batter, all runners advance to home.
10. All players play every defensive half of an inning. The infielders and catcher play at their designated positions. All remaining players play in the outfield. No player will play in the same position more than one inning. Note: The coach does not have to put players in a position if the child's safety is a concern.
11. No more than two coaches will be positioned in the outfield grass to help position their players. Offensively, adult coaches will base coach at first and third. One adult must be in the dugout with substitutes.
12. Adults on the field are not defensive players and must avoid contact with the ball.
13. Base race will be run at the conclusion of each game unless weather or time makes it unsafe or impractical.
