a. Pre-Application Conference

- i. <u>UGA-AC-20-005 0 Jackson Highway 42 Multi-Family Units:</u> Dan Hawes is proposing to build a total of 42 multi-family units in the UGA.
 - Dan and Aaron describe proposed project. Mapped wetland in middle of site so will be doing a wetland delineation. There are existing utilities, sewer and water.
 D. Hawes mentions the units will be identical to Jackson Villa townhomes. 21 buildings, 42 units.
 - C. Wilder states that this property will tie into the city sewer. If irrigation, please
 provide backflow. Street improvements will be deferred to the county. Road
 approach and right-of-way permits will also be through the county. C. Wilder
 suggests a commercial road approach. Energy code checklist will be required for
 permits on this project.
 - R. Mack says fire separation walls are okay if units are side by side vs. stacked top and bottom. He also says the turn-around space for emergency vehicles does look sufficient per the preliminary site plan provided.
 - T. Baraconi states that if wetlands are to be filled, mitigation will need to be discussed. She would also like to see a designated amenity space outside for residents. Will need garbage enclosures and she would prefer to see masonry. Stormwater calculations. Currently the area is zoned single-family homes. If choosing to do multi-family, will need conditional use permit. SEPA and public hearings can take 3-4 months. Will need separate permits for each building. A geotechnical report is needed but does not have to be the full report. Windshield survey should be suffice.
