## Site Plan Review:

<u>ST-21-0018</u>; 422 S Market Blvd. Fuller Designs is proposing to build a 1500 sq ft pharmacy with a drive-thru, paved parking, bioswale, and retaining wall. In CG zone, "drug store over 5000 square feet," and "convenience store 1,001-5,000 sq feet" are permitted uses (drug store under 5,000 square feet is not a listed category). Lewis County Parcel #004918000000.

Applicant Present: Aaron Fuller with Fuller Design

- 1. T. Baraconi, Building and Planning Manager opens meeting with Zoom attendees and presents DRC Agenda on projector for staff and applicant to reference.
- 2. A. Fuller, Fuller Design notifies staff that Devon will not be attending. Briefly describes project of pharmacy on existing lot. The access issue in the back has been addressed giving them a 20-foot easement along the back. The retaining wall was removed at one point but will be put back. Curb gutter and sidewalk will be done along 4<sup>th</sup>. The old landscaping strip will be brought back. There is enough handicap parking and adequate space for the drive thru. The drainage underground outlets to corner of Market and 4<sup>th</sup>.
- 3. R. Mack, Fire Marshal- will need commercial addressing on the building. Fire protection is all existing. Asks Aaron if there will be an alarm system.
- 4. A. Fuller, Fuller Design- not sure, there might be a standard system.
- 5. R. Mack, Fire Marshal- if there is an alarm system installed a knox box will be required.
- 6. Brandon Rakes, Airport Manager- no concerns from the airport.
- 7. Angie Elder, Police Department- no on street parking. There is ample on-site parking.
- 8. A. Fuller, Fuller Design- 1 through 9 stormwater requirements have been submitted.
- 9. Celest Wilder, Public Works-the legal description of the easement must be approved by Public Works prior to recording. Water & Sewer are current.
- 10. A. Fuller, Fuller Design shows water and sewer on plans to staff.
- 11. C. Wilder, Public Works- asks A. Fuller is this will be a compounding pharmacy. If so, they will require an oil/water separator.
- 12. A. Fuller, Fuller Design responds to C. Wilder, not that he is aware of but if so, will you allow small separator underneath the sink?
- 13. C. Wilder, Public Works- responds to A. Fuller, if that is allowed by code.
- 14. Lance Bunker, Streets/Stormwater Superintendent looks straight forward from street side and storm side.
- 15. Amelia Schwartz, City Planner- no further comments.
- 16. T. Baraconi, Building and Planning Manager- a licensed landscape architect will be required for landscaping, please meet all the conditions from the other departments. The group here approves. You will receive a letter within 10 business days for approval with conditions.

17. A. Fuller, Fuller Design- will continue to work on the last items, understands to provide Public Works directly with further information.
