



NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY TITLE VI NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The City of Chehalis, Washington (City) hereby gives public notice that it is the City's policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, and related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities. Title VI requires that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, sex, or national origin, be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any Federal Aid Highway program or activity for which the City receives federal financial assistance.

Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discrimination practice under Title VI has a right to file a formal complaint with the City. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with the City's Title VI Coordinator within one hundred eighty (180) days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence. Title VI Discrimination forms and policy may be obtained from the Title VI Coordinator at no cost to the complainant or online at www.ci.chehalis.wa.us/cityclerk.
